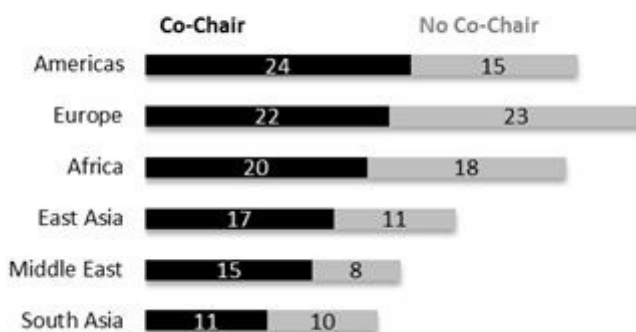


Private Sector Country Council Leadership Summary

The presence of private sector leadership at the Country Councils, as reported by the Regional Security Officer averages **56% globally**. While not all Country Councils require private sector leadership to hold meetings, constituent leadership is an indicator of Council health and predictor of Council longevity.
