OUR MISSION

Founded in 2011 by private-sector members of the Overseas Security Advisory Council (OSAC), the nonprofit International Security Foundation (ISF) protects U.S. interests overseas through education, information sharing and funding the Overseas Security Advisory Council and other security-related organizations. ISF support from individual and corporate donations has created a stronger, more responsive OSAC, since the Federal Advisory Committee Act prohibits OSAC from using federal funds for public-private event programming.

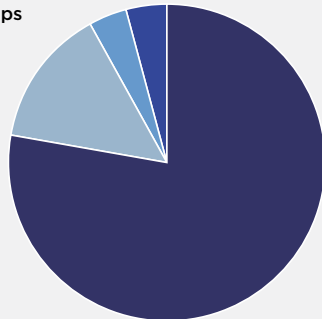

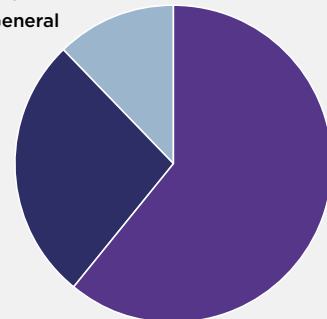
ISF SOURCES OF REVENUE
